# ABOUT ME



I am Amit Somabhai Limbachiya. I was born in very middle-class family. I am married and I have 5 years old daughter. When I was born my father was a worker in the factory and his earning was very low. Due to the low salary, sometime we had difficulties to get food and money for education.

When I was six years old, one day I had a very high fever. My parents got frightened and rushed to the doctor. The doctor immediately gave me the injection.

After one hour I was playing normally but due to injection my right leg muscles stretched and pulled. My father realized the difference in me after one day because I was unable to walk and needed support to stand up.

**My father took me to the same doctor again. And there we found out from one of the nurses who was working in his clinic, that the doctor didn't change the needle when he injected the injection in me. Doctor used same needle which was used on previous patients. My father was very angry with the doctor and asked him to get me to recover as soon as possible.**

The doctor gave assurance to my father that he will try his best to get him recovered but he was lying to my father and just gave us false assurance but nothing else. We were middle-class family so couldn't afford the court fees so we didn't knock the court door.

But my father is my real hero and role model. He didn't give up on my situation. He took me to Balasinor, a city located in the Kheda Mahisagar district of Gujarat, India. The Balasinor hospital doctor recommended us to do ultra-violet light therapy which will help to recover poliomyelitis.

**My father carried me on his shoulder every time and travelled 70 Kms from home and taking me to the hospital for this therapy.**

We did this therapy for one and half year then finally I was able to walk slowly with the support. When I was 7 and half-year-old, I started to walk independently but my right leg became shorter than the left leg.



Due to that, I was limping but at least I have started walking. I am thankful to my father to encouraging me whenever I am in a difficult situation.

I have completed my schooling in Saint Merry high School, Tarsali Vadodara Gujarat. I got 80% in the Secondary Board. After 10th board, I got admission in the Science stream. After 12th, I took admission in L.M College of Pharmacy (LMCP), Ahmedabad in 2004. LMCP is one of the best colleges of pharmacy in India. After done 4 years of Bachelor of pharmacy, I went to Australia in 2008 for the Master of Pharmacy but due to high college fees, I couldn't afford to pay fees. I changed my course and got admission to community welfare. This course was for 2 years.

Along with this course, I have accomplished multiple connected courses like, PBST (Positive Behaviour Support Therapy), BLST (Basic Lifestyle Support Therapy), DSP (Disability Support Practice), OHS (Occupational Health & Safety), Manual Handling, Body Systems, First Aid Certificate from Brisbane, Australia.

**In 2010, while I was studying, I got the job offer in one of the well-known organizations in Australia as a case officer. The role of the case officer is to coordinating and providing care that is safe, timely, effective, efficient, equitable, and client centered. Handling case assignments, draft service plans, review case progress and determine case closure.**

Helping clients achieve wellness and autonomy. This role was amazing. I got different opportunities to work with different aged groups like child, adults and seniors. My job role was to visit different organizations and do case study on people who are suffering from cerebral palsy, dementia, Alzheimer's, Parkinson's, Leukemia, Intellectual disability, multiple sclerosis, spinal cord injuries, schizophrenic and multiple disorders in aged care.

**While I was working in this organization, I got an idea that why can't I open up such type of the facility in India where bedridden, terminally ill and immobile senior citizens can get benefits.**



In India, millions of bedridden elders are there but we don't have such facilities like rehabilitation aged care homes or assisted living facilities or hospice (neither hospital nor home, in-between option) where bedridden seniors can get services like nursing care, medical attention, nutritious food, physiotherapy, ongoing doctor's visits and most importantly human touch under one roof. This idea didn't allow me to sleep.

**My organization was offering \$55,000 package in 2011 and asked me to stay with them but I rejected this offer and came back to India permanently. My parents were unhappy and very disappointed with this decision but I told them to trust me.**

When I came to India permanently in 2011, I have started giving services to bedridden senior citizens at their home. Home care services like nurses, care takers, physiotherapist, doctor, psychologist, massage therapist and other allied health care services. The main reason behind providing all above services at home so I can do the analysis of how many actual seniors are looking for center based services. We got extraordinary responses from people and that encouraged me to open aged care facility in Vadodara Gujarat.

I have founded the organization name called, "Swarg Community Care" on 14th April 2012. The name, "SWARG", itself was very catchy and correlated to seniors.

The reason behind this name is after senior's death whether they can go to Swarg (heaven) or not but before they die, they can come in this SWARG (Swarg on earth) and enjoy their remaining life at best. The purpose of the Swarg is to give high-quality solutions for seniors living with paralysis, immobile, neurological disorders, terminally ill and those elderly who are unable to look after themselves at home in India.

**Our objectives are to treat seniors with the dignity and respect, being considerate of others, recognizing strengths, responding to their choices and needs for service support.**

“Swarg” is one in his kind. “Swarg” is the Gujarat’s first rehabilitation and residential aged care facility in Vadodara Gujarat India. Initially, I started with 10 beds facility to see how the response will come up. I have received tremendous response from the people. I have increased the bed capacity from 10 to 30 beds and 30 to 70 beds and 70 to 100 beds in 6 years.

In April 2019, looking at the needs of senior citizens and fast developing generation and cultures. I have opened another branch in Ahmedabad, Gujarat India. Swarg Ahmedabad branch has 50 beds capacity.

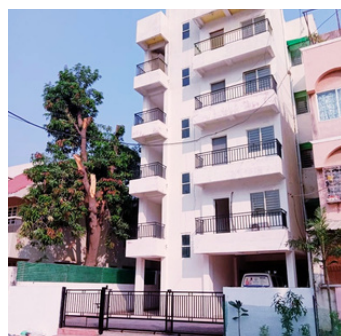

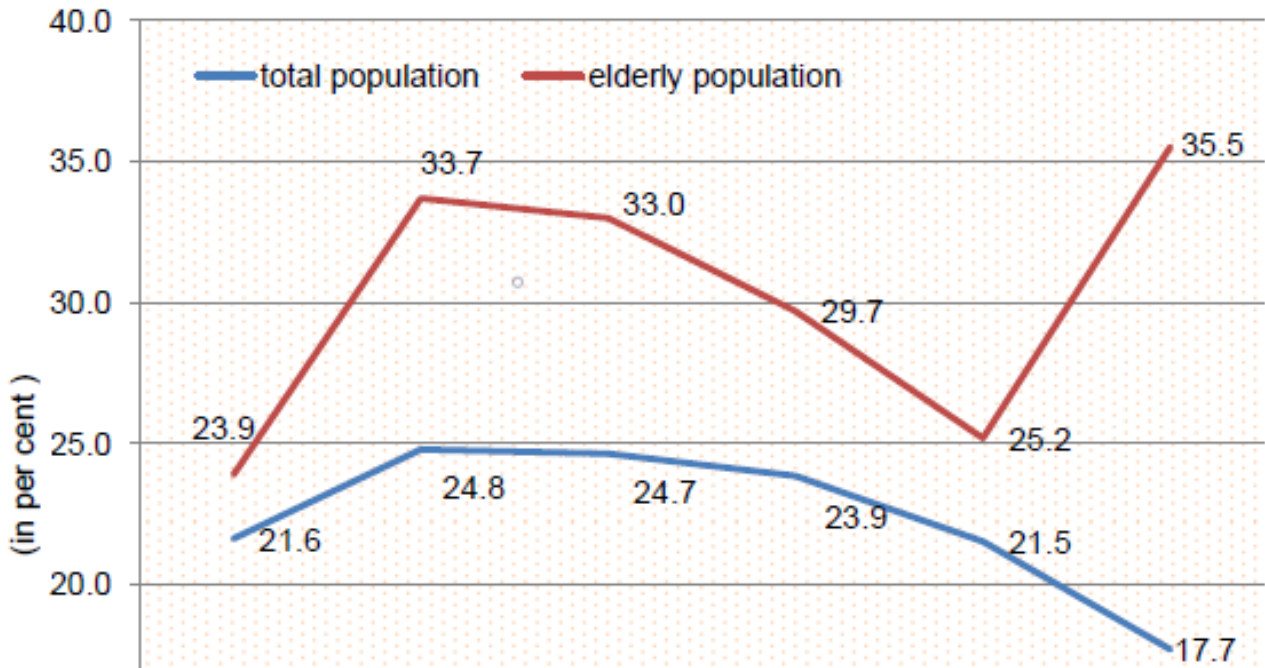

## **PURPOSE OF SWARG EXISTANCE**

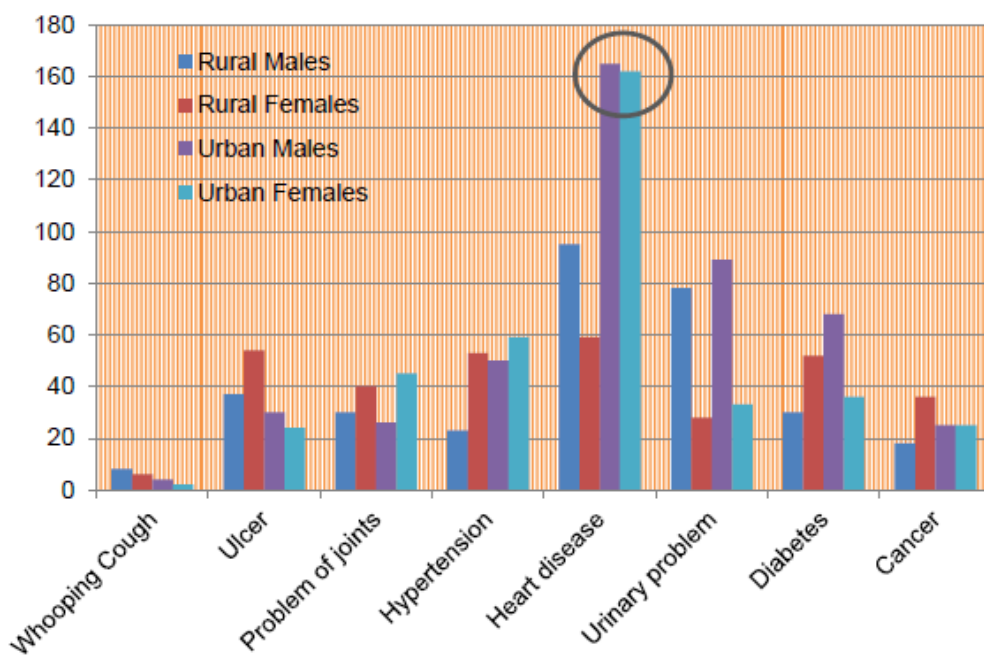
Let us establish the need of Swarg Community Care (SCC) in Gujarat; Millions of senior citizens cross the globe are facing health problems. By 2025, there will about 1200 million people aged 65 years according to UN estimates. Failure to address old age health needs today could develop into a costly problem tomorrow. Seven percent of the 1.1 billion Indian population is today over the age of 60. They too wish to have a better access to health care, look forward to fun, health, dignity, economic independence and a peaceful death.

Indian Ministry estimates say the number of people in the 60-plus age group in India will increase to 100 million in 2013, and 198 million in 2030.

The elderly population will increase to 12% of the total population by 2025, 10% of whom would be bedridden, requiring utmost care. The ministry's revised National Programme for the Healthcare of the Elderly (NPHCE) expects to have 20 institutions with capacity to produce 40 post-graduates in MD in geriatric medicine per year. Additionally, 7,400 beds in district hospitals and 2,000 beds in medical colleges for the elderly by 2021.

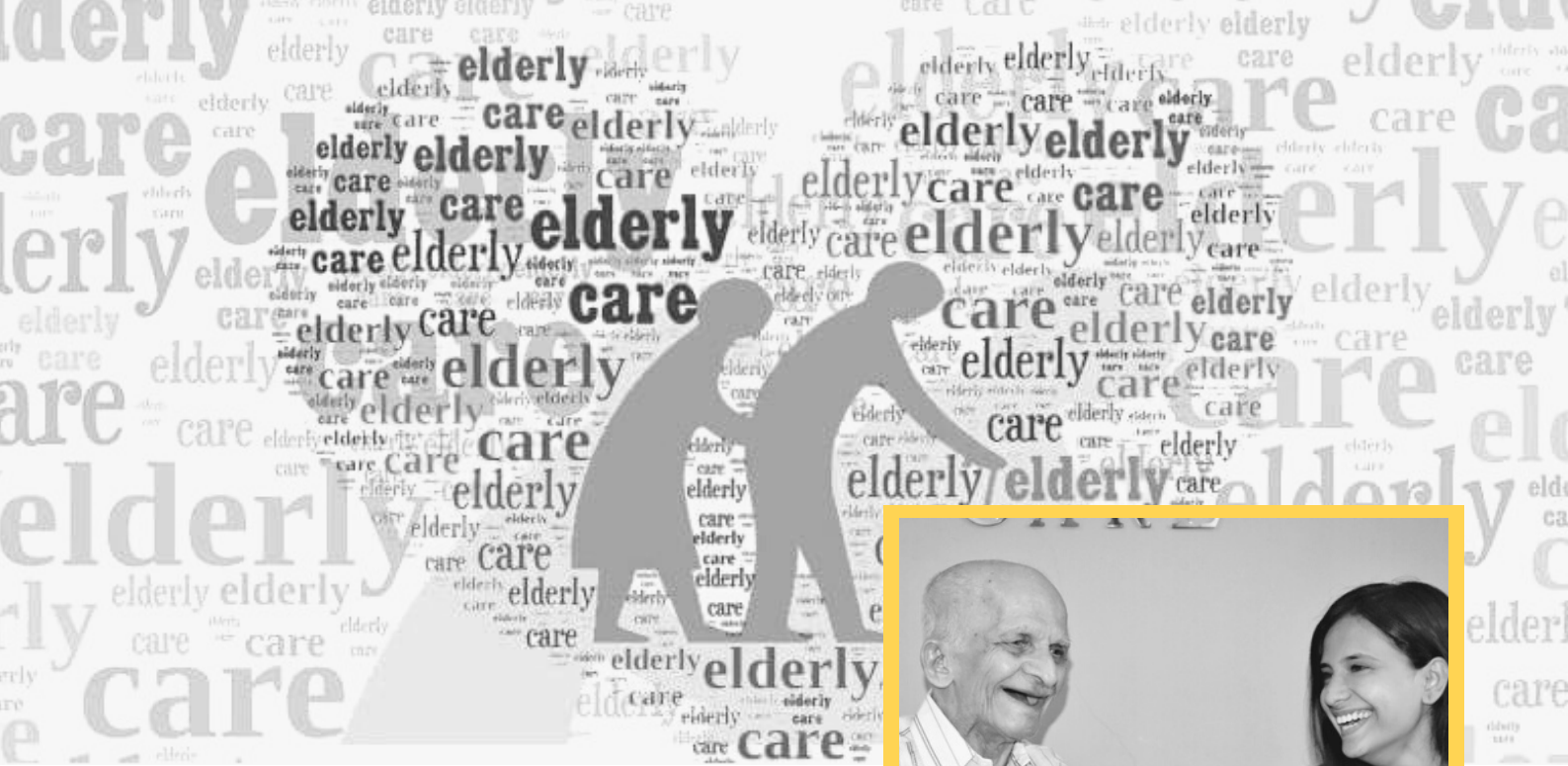

### The other reasons are

- India will soon become home to the second largest senior citizens' population in the world.
- A majority (80%) of them would be in rural areas, making medical service delivery a challenge.
- 54% of the elderly population would be women by 2021.
- Elder maltreatment can lead to serious physical injuries and long-term psychological consequences.
- The global population of people aged 60 years and older would more than double, from 542 million in 1995 to about 1.2 billion in 2025.
- Maltreatment of senior citizens is an important public health problem.

### Problems being faced by bedridden sufferer at home

- 24 Hour care attention required
- Expense of employing personal care takers. Reliability of care taker is always question marked.
- Expensive hygiene tools such as diapers etc. Lack of medical care knowledge in family.
- Ongoing requirements of Physiotherapist, Counselor & doctor's visit.
- Lack of emotional support due to their prolonged disability. Lack of help in daily activities.
- Non-availability of opportunities for creative use of time. Persistent ill health.
- Insufficient infrastructure for quality personal care.
- Entire responsibility of care and support falls on primary family member, which results in an imbalance within the family members.
- Lack of companionship makes elderly loneliness, anxious feeling and it effect on social, mental or emotional factors. Due to that it may risk on health and elderly convert in depression mood which may makes them to do anti-social activities. Which may result of health issues.

## Employees Relations



- Since 2012 Swarg has served more than 1500 bedridden terminally ill, immobile, mentally retarded seniors. Our recovery ratio is 82%.

She is admitted at Swarg on 20th July 2020. She had a brain stroke and right side paralyzed. She was disoriented, speech difficulties, feeding, catheterized & weak. After rehabilitation aged care, she got recovered in 15 days. She started talking and eating by mouth in 10 days.

She is admitted at Swarg on 03/06/2014. She had a history of K/C/O HTN presents with CVA (RT Hemiparesis, small Hematoma in It Thalamo Capsular Region with minimal edema & Contralateral Midline shift). She had a tracheostomy, Ryle's tube, Catheterized & couldn't walk. After proper physiotherapy, personal and nursing care, she got recovered in 29 days.

She was admitted in Swarg July 2016 before. Her medical and physical conditions were unstable. Family even lost their hope about her recovery but after 1 month of care at Swarg, she can walk with Walker or with nominal support. We feel blessed when people get their life back.

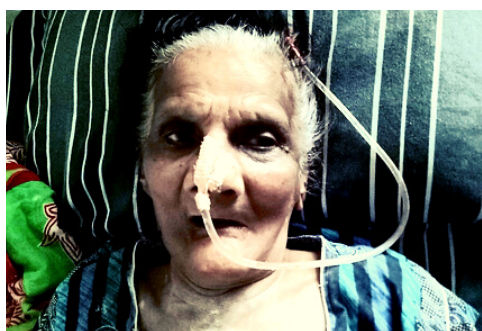
Swarg Community Care – An elderly home, is itself heaven for people like us – says Kokilaben Shah, a respectable resident of Swarg who was admitted here for Rehab purposes. Below given is a short description of her journey at Swarg.

2 months ago, Kokilaben visited some religious place with her husband and so while walking downstairs, her foot got twisted and she lost her balance, fell down on her face, got hurt, and was unconscious. Then, she was taken to VINS hospital via ambulance and got admitted to ICU for 5 days where Ryle's tube and Urine catheter was inserted and she was unconscious during that duration.

After few days, the patient regained back her consciousness but used to be in a drowsy state. Then, one of her relatives recommended Swarg Community Care. So, when she came to Swarg, she was in a drowsy state, not able to speak, bed-ridden, unable to sit or stand. Ryle's tube and urine catheter was also inserted and she was on a liquid diet. Gradually, she started improving within 1 month with proper nursing care and regular physiotherapy sessions.

Now, she is able to sit and stand with little support, and her Ryle's tube and the catheter have also been removed. And now she can also communicate properly.

Kokilaben and her family are Thankful to the whole Swarg Family.

A lady with lot of determination and enthusiasm, who came to Swarg on 10th January 21 and was completely bedridden with cellulites of quite large size on her left leg. She was not able to sit on her own, also not able to bear weight on her legs.

So, since day- 1, we started her Physiotherapy Treatment as well as took proper care of cellulites – which actually needed proper dressing. Slowly, her wound got healed and she was able to bear weight on her legs gradually. Also, she had mild contractures over knee area, so a minor surgical procedure called Tenotomy was done so that her knee muscles will be lengthened slightly and then she was able to walk with her proper weight bearing on her legs with help of walker.

Kananbaa were really Thankful to Swarg Team as she didn't expect such drastic recovery within a period of one and half month.

Vaibhav Shah, a Trainer by Profession came to swarg on 20th April, 2021 and was completely bedridden. When he came, he was diagnosed with CVA stroke and was on urine catheter. His RT side was completely paralyzed and was not able to sit, stand or bear wt on his limbs.

After coming to swarg, the very next day we started his physiotherapy and gradually he was able to move his limbs and bear wt on his legs.

We gave him E.S. as well for muscle activation and strengthening. Nursing care and Diet plan also played an imported role in his recovery.

Being a Trainer, he always wanted to get recover as soon as possible and now at this stage walking on his own, he is really happy and Thankful to Swarg Team.

Dinesh Bhai is a very enthusiastic person who is full of energy.

During the second wave of covid-19, he was affected badly and was admitted to the hospital for treatment. He got recovered from covid-19 but then he suffered from a brain stroke. Due to the right side of his body stopped working and was affected with slurred speech. After getting discharged from the hospital his relative admitted him to Swarg Community Care for rehabilitation purposes. His physiotherapy treatment, as well as nursing care, was taken by Swag's staff.

Initially, he was very depressed with his condition but gradually with proper nursing care and support from staff, his condition got improved. His physical condition is very much better due to physiotherapy treatment. He is now able to walk independently with the help of a stick, able to climb stairs, and doing most of the activities by himself.

He and his family members are thankful to the Swarg team.

Mr. Amit Thakore, Resident of Swarg Community Care, Vadodara.

He is suffering from Cerebellum Atrophy.

Before talking about him let me tell you something about this condition. Cerebellum atrophy refers to the deterioration of neurons (nerve cells) in the cerebellum, the area of the brain that controls muscle coordination and balance. Signs and symptoms may include wide-based uncoordinated walk, a back-and-forth tremor of the trunk of the body, uncoordinated movement of arms and legs, slow and slurred speech, and nystagmus (vision condition in which eyes make repetitive and uncontrolled movements). This can be diagnosed by CT-Scan or MRI. Treatment is usually based on signs and symptoms.

Amit Bhai came in Swarg with Cerebellum Atrophy. He was not able to sit without support, was suffering from poor balance, coordination, and decreased muscle strength, and has slurred speech. So, we started Physiotherapy treatments like Coordination Exercise, Balancing Exercise, Muscle Strengthening Exercise, Gait Training, etc. he cooperates during treatment and therefore we can see improvement in his condition.

Moreover, the nursing staff of Swarg is also taking proper care of his diet and overall condition and because of the overall care and moral support given by the Swarg team; we are able to **bring a smile to his face**. It is worthwhile for him to come in Swarg.

The entertainer resident of Swarg – Ushakant Hathi

He came to Swarg 2 months ago and was a post covid patient and because of which he was completely bedridden and had other complaints like generalized weakness, pain in legs, dyspnea on exertion. So after few days with proper muscle strengthening, gait training, and modalities which were given to reduce his pain, he was able to walk with a walker. Also, breathing ex. were started side by side for proper respiration, and with proper food intake and nursing help he can now walk independently.

- After studies, most of the students are prone to relocate and continue their life in a different country. While parents get old and start living a lonely, insecure and stressful life without realizing it. For some parents, it's hard to relocate and accept foreign life, so they prefer to stay in India. While living alone at home without any primary family member they find it hard to survive in this fast and rapidly changing world. It's hard for far living family members to look after the safety and security of old parents, medical and surgical requirements, pathology laboratory reports, look after mental health and other daily chores of parents. This creates friction and dilemma between family members. Here, Swarg offers them a carefree, stress-free and independent life for all the family members.

- Now a day’s Joint family are converting into nuclear family and all individuals are busy with their routines. In this situation, family members are unable to look after their bedridden parents. Swarg is giving solution for this kind of dilemma where family members can provide the best medical and nursing care without skipping their work hours or a day in office. They can visit them, or pick and drop them as per the suitability of patients and family members.



- Senior Medical & Physical Condition Issue - “Swarg” has recovered following seniors from their medical condition & physical condition like Respiratory Disorders, Neurological Disorder, Musculoskeletal Disorders, after Hospital Care or Palliative Care, Kidney related problems, Cancer Patients, Cardiac Diseases, Mentally Retarded.
